Recap of Rental Law Changes

- Increased Compliance Requirements (Reg 30, p22) for gas/electrical safety checks, pool barrier compliance, and efficiency systems for urgent repairs by resident.
- (p179-186) Schedule Minimum covers Standards like locks, vermin proof bins, toilets, bathroom facilities, kitchen facilities, laundry facilities, structural soundness, moulds dampness, electrical safety, window coverings, windows, lighting, ventilation and heating.
- Mandatory Disclosure Statements (Reg 16, p10), are now much broader, including if it has been the location of a homicide or contaminated because of drugs in the last 5 years, if it complies with rental minimum standards, if a repair notice for mould or damp has been received related to building structure, and more.
